

## Luxury AL Ula (3 Nights)

### Itinerary:

#### Day 1- Al Ula

On arrival in Al Ula, you will be met and transferred to Hotel.



#### **Old town Tour – SIC tours**

Get a glimpse into Al Ula's not-so-distant past on the Old Town Tour. A guide will lead you through Al Ula's Old Town, where pilgrims, travelers and permanent settlers congregated through the ages. Inhabited from before the 12th century up until the early 1980's, Old Town offers researchers unique oral histories and living memory that the area's other heritage sites cannot. With 900 houses, 500 shops and 5 town squares, you can explore a maze of remnants of original stone and mudbrick buildings and enjoy views of an Al Ula Castle dating back to the 10th century.



#### **Harrat Viewpoint**

Al Ula is blessed with numerous lookout points that offer an elevated view of the epic landscape, but none quite as epic as Harrat Viewpoint. Stand at what feels like the edge of the world, overlooking deep canyons, the lush green Oasis and incredible rock formations as far as the eye can see.

## Day 2- Al Ula

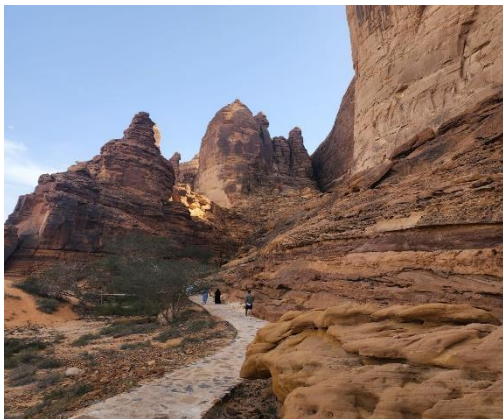
Following breakfast, you will be escorted to Winter Park to board the bus for your seat on the coach tour.

### Dadan & Jabal Ikamah Day Tour- SIC tours



#### **Dadan**

The first stop on this journey back in time is Dadan, the ancient Kingdom of the Lihyanite and Dadanite civilizations.



#### **Jabal Ikamah**

Next, a coach bus takes you on a 10-minute drive to Jabal Ikamah. Set in a stunning desert canyon, this 'open-air library' has the most impressive collection of inscriptions, rock art, and petroglyphs in Al Ula and is the largest of its kind in Saudi Arabia.



#### **Maraya Social Dinner:**

One of Britain's best-loved chefs and owner of Michelin-starred restaurants worldwide, Jason Atherton opened Maraya Social on the rooftop of the award-winning Maraya. A selection of sharing plates and quality mocktails are sourced from seasonal produce and feature Mediterranean, Arabian and British cuisine. Relax, dine, and socialize whilst surrounded by the glorious views of the rock-strewn canyons of Ashar Valley. **(Passengers will get a credit of SAR 150 per person which can be adjusted against your final billing; Passengers needs to settle the difference on own, we will be just booking the table reservation)**



### **Heritage Oasis Trail Tour**

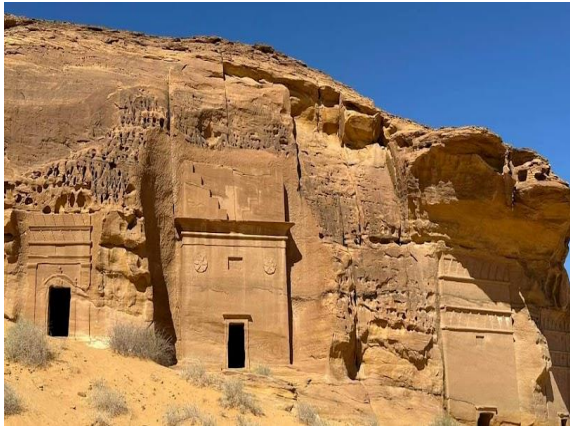
This 3km tour along Al Ula's Heritage Oasis Trail is a fabulous way to immerse yourself in the natural beauty of the Oasis while learning about its important role in Al Ula's history. The tour starts with typical Al Ula hospitality – dates, dried fruits and coffee – and an introduction to the Oasis by your expert guide. You'll then be led along the scenic trail, parts shaded under towering date palms, other sections opening to sunny clearings with stunningly verdant panoramas. You'll pass farmlands restored to their former

splendor, growing the fruit and vegetables that end up in the kitchens of farm-to-table restaurants. There'll be time to take photos at numerous picture-perfect locations en route. The tour ends at the palm swings, one of the most iconic sites on the trail, where you can gently sway in the breeze or swing high into the air. No visit to AL Ula is truly complete without a visit to this wonderful Oasis.

### **Day3- Al Ula**

### **Hegra – SIC tours**

Reach back into the past and encounter Al Ula's ancient cultures and learn about how people lived. Observe expertly carved stone blocks that acted as representations of the gods. Away from Hegra's captivating tombs, this ancient Nabataean city also boasts examples of ancient engineering and craftsmanship such as wells and stone-lined water channels. Defensive walls, gates and towers that once encircled the city show the Roman influence at Hegra. Rest of the day free for leisure or **explore Al-Jadidah Arts District**



**Elephant Rock:** A true icon of Al Ula, the elephant shaped rock formation stretches up 52 meters into the sky, its warm-hued sandstone shaped by wind and water erosion over the course of millions of years. Known in Arabic as Jabal Al Fil, Elephant Rock is particularly magical at dusk when the fading sun casts a bewitching deep crimson light over the trunk and body of Al Ula's famous geological pachyderm.
